

GENERAL RULES

1. Acceptance of the rules and acceptance of the judge's decision as final is a condition of entry.
2. Hard Hats to be worn to BSEN 1384 or PAS015 with fastened harness and correct footwear to be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
3. Correct attire to be worn: shirt and tie/stock with hacking/show jacket or TWIN TREES Sweatshirt only. However, a Show Jacket or Hacking Jacket must be worn for the Championship. In the event of bad weather waterproofs may be worn. Please check with the judge at the time of class.
4. Any objection lodged must be accompanied by £20.00 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
5. No responsibility for loss, damage or injury to horse/rider, rider, spectator or property will be accepted by the Organisers.
6. The Organisers reserve the right to alter, modify, reduce, amalgamate, cancel or make any alterations to classes without notice.
7. All classes judged in conjunction with British Dressage Rules & Twin Trees Riders Club Rules.
8. Any dogs on site must be kept on a lead and any excrement cleared up. Please do not take into arenas.
9. No horse/pony under 4 years may compete
10. No Stallions on the show ground without prior arrangement with the Organisers.
11. No lungeing on the show ground.
12. Entry fees can only be refunded on production of Veterinary/ Doctor's Certificate.
13. A competitor may ride a maximum of two horses per class.
14. Please keep car park tidy. Do not leave hay or droppings behind.

Late entries may be accepted if time permits at £1 extra per entry. £1 First Aid Cover per competitor. Entries to arrive no later than one week before the Competition. Entry Forms are available on website.

If you intend to leave before the end of the class and wish your score sheet to be forwarded to you please leave a SAE large letter rate with the secretary or add £1 to entry fee.

TIMES: For your times enter email address clearly on entry form so that it can be sent to you. They will also be able to be viewed on www.twintrees.net or telephone 01767 627414 between 5.00pm-6.00pm on Friday before competition. Good Friday Times will be available on Wednesday 31 March.

AWARDS: Rosettes to 6th place in each class. Competitors placed 1st – 4th in a class or achieve at least 58% will qualify for the Championships in September. Qualification Cards will be emailed out to you after the event.
