

## RING 4 9.00am Fun Ring

9-12 noon Clear round jumping £3 per round. (2 rounds for £5) Rosette to all clears.

CLASS 26 Horse and Hound Small course of fences to be jumped firstly by horse and rider, then by rider and dog against the clock. In this class the horse may compete twice. May be split a) under 12's b) 12 years and over

CLASS 27 Hound and Handler One round against the clock, dog and handler jump together. The hound may compete more than once with a rest period between goes!!! Maybe split a) under 12's b) 12 yrs and over

**AWARDS:** Rosettes to 6th. Trophies to 3rd if sufficient entries.

**MEMBERS LEAGUE:** Points will also be awarded for member's leagues which run throughout the season for the annual Jumping trophies with a Trophy being awarded after the Championship Show for each level which members will keep for the year. (Classes 2,3,4,6)



### Show Jumping Championships

**Chiltern & Thames Rider** To qualify riders must hold a C&T Rider SJ member number. Riders must buy their membership numbers from C&T Rider prior to the competition.

**\*Twin Trees** Over the season there are 4 classes for which members can qualify: Mini, Pre-Novice, Novice and Open Challenge. Qualifier's Height: 45, 60, 75, 90cm in first round respectively. Those placed 1st to 3rd qualify, as do those riders who jump double clear for the Championship on 3 October. Please make sure the secretary has your email address so the Qualifying Card can be sent to you.

**Special Rule:** A pony/horse may qualify with two riders in Mini Champs for those who share equines.

2. Hard Hats to be worn to EN 1384 or PAS015 with fastened harness and correct footwear to be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
3. Correct attire to be worn: shirt and tie/stock with hacking/show jacket or Twin Trees Sweatshirt only.
4. Any objection lodged must be accompanied by £20.00 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
5. No responsibility for loss, damage or injury to horse/rider, rider, spectator or property will be accepted by the Organisers.
6. The Organisers reserve the right to alter, reduce, amalgamate, cancel or make any alterations to classes without notice.
7. All classes judged in conjunction with BSJA & Twin Trees Riders Club Rules.
8. Competitors may be led or have assistance where the fence height is 45cm or less .
9. Any dogs on site must be kept on a lead and any excrement cleared up. Please do not take into main arenas.
10. No horse/pony under 4 years may be ridden on show ground.
11. No Stallions on the show ground without prior arrangement with the Organisers.
12. No lungeing on the show ground.
13. Entry fees can only be refunded on production of Veterinary/ Doctor's Certificate.
14. Please keep car park tidy. Do not leave hay or droppings behind.
